Senior Alysha Ziemba will attend Kent State University. She said her family had a bit of influence on her choice since she did not want to move far away.

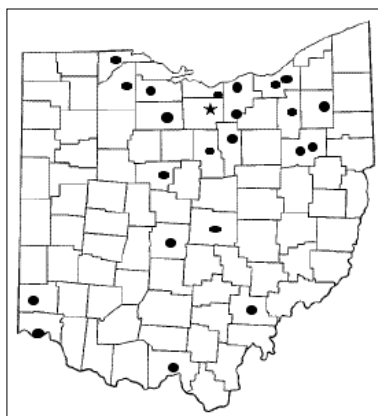
Ziemba wants to become a neurophysiologist. She said she

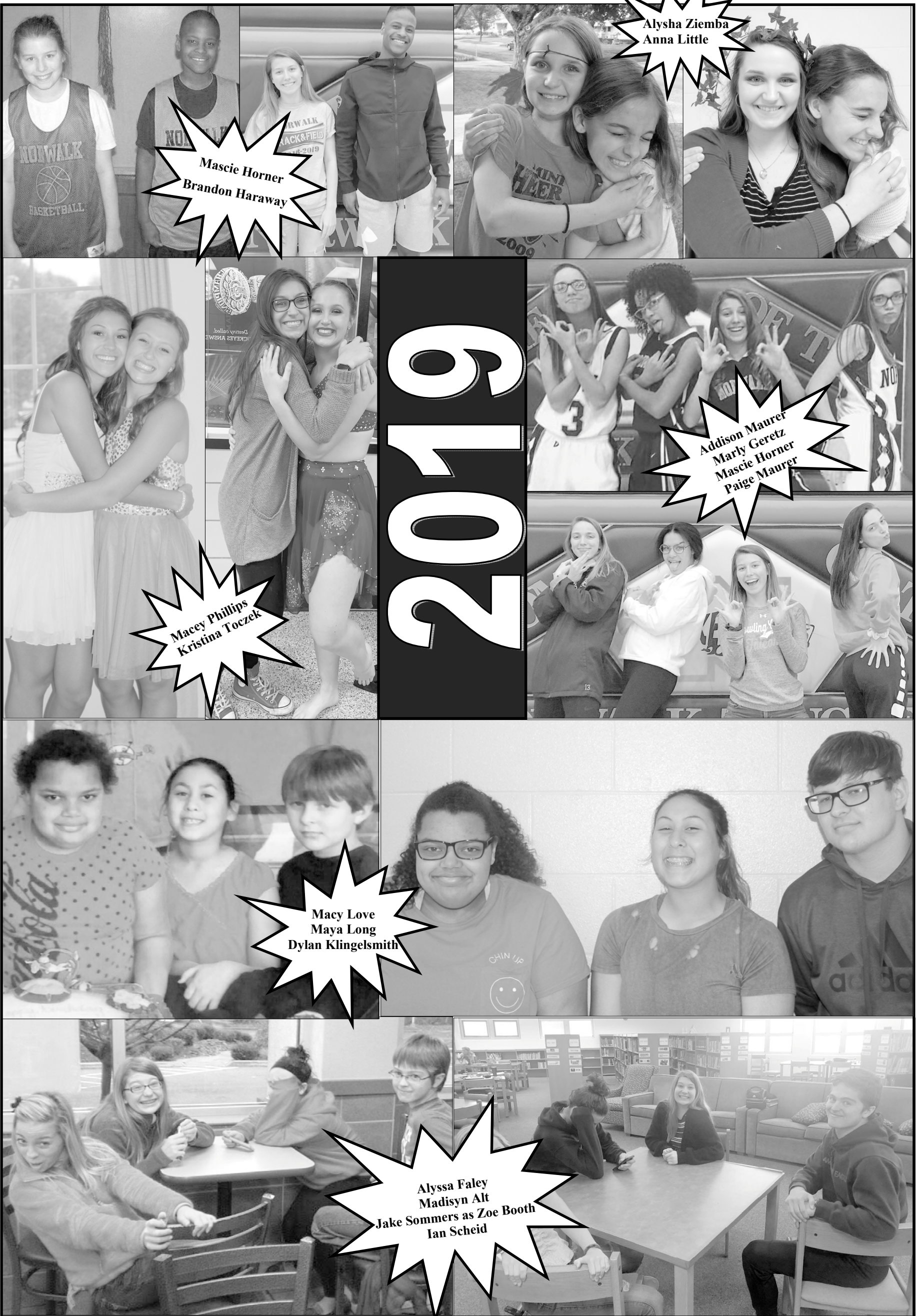
