## Grade KDG

- 1-Large Book Bag (<u>no wheels</u>)- please label with name
- 1-Personal Headphones anything with a 3.5MM jack (standard) (label with name)
- 1-Crayola Crayons (8 count) Large Size (not jumbo)
- 3- Crayola Crayons (24 count) Regular Size
- 2 -Classic Color Crayola Markers- Not thin
- 2- Yellow Highlighters- wide tip
- 1- Blunt nosed Fiskars Scissors (label with name)
- 3- 4oz Bottles of ELMER'S White Glue (label with name)
- 2 -Three-prong/pocket folders- plain colors (NO pictures), do not label with name
