The pick-up and drop off procedure is improving with each day. Just a few friendly reminders regarding the pick-up procedure at the end of the day:

- 1. Please do not use the second lane to pick up students.
- 2. The lane nearest the fence is to be used to pick up or drop off students.
- 3. Students are not to cross the first lane to get in or out of a vehicle in the second lane or into a parked car.
- 4. The second lane from the fence is to be left open for vehicles who have loaded or unloaded students and are leaving the grounds.
- 5. If you need to get your student before the end of the day, please park and come to the office to sign your student out.
- 6. ALL vehicles should leave the school via Taylor St.
